#### **About the Product**

A triple distilled Whiskey from barley, rye, and corn aged three years in once-used Boatwright Bourbon barrels. We distill deeper in the “tails” of the distillation cuts and to a lower proof during the process, which brings out some richer, more unique flavors. This is a lighter whiskey; flavorful but not as robust and dark as our Bourbon and Rye, reminiscent of an Irish-style whiskey.

#### **The Name**

Old School is both a fun description of this whiskey and a reference to the schools of herring fish that flood into the Chilkoot and Chilkat Inlets each spring. This spirit is matured in our “old” bourbon barrels for 3 years and is an “old”, or well known, style of a smooth flavorful whiskey many people will recognize as a favorite.



#### **The Sea Creature**

Herring: “Schools” of shiny, silver herring swimming up the Chilkoot and Chilkat Inlet is a sure sign of spring. This limited-time event often corresponds with the limited-release of our Old School Whiskey.
